Students returned to the classroom April 6th following Easter break. They all came back eager to learn and happy to be together again. We celebrated Anna's birthday and Earth Day.

Students worked on writing their alphabet. They wrote their names mosaic style with lots of colorful paper. They did a fun egg themed alphabet page about upper and lower case letters, and a raindrop number page. They worked on their tracing by completing a worksheet about rainy weather because April showers bring May flowers. The students continued practicing writing their numbers and learning their colors. They were introduced to the number line, and completed a color and shape worksheet. In addition, we made some birthday cards, worked on our alphabet books, and studied Bible and spring sight words. We read Star Wars Colors, Naked Trevor, and Muff in a Puff. We worked on a sequencing worksheet about flowers.

We worked on Earth Day lesson plans and art all month. We completed a lesson on plant parts and plant needs. If you need help in your gardens, your kids are ready.
